

CHAIRMAN DONATES NUCLEAR DECOMMISSIONING EQUIPMENT TO THE ASSOCIATION

R. Jon Stouky, the President of Mega-Tech Services, Inc. has donated a set of valuable decommissioning pipe and structural steel cutting tools built specifically for nuclear decommissioning by Mega-Tech. The tools, high powered (10,000 PSIG) hand held cutting tools that will sever a 1.5" stainless steel pipe in a few seconds, will be kept available for the decommissioning of the SAVANNAH and turned over to the ship when appropriate. If the ship does not go into a decommissioning mode, the equipment can be disposed of in a manner consistent with the IRS and corporate requirements. A 10,000 PSIG 5 HP Hydraulic Power Unit and necessary hoses and fittings are included.



Equipment identical to this is used worldwide for decommissioning of nuclear power plants and other facilities.

The equipment will be stored aboard the SAVANNAH for the Association, and the attached photo was taken when the tools arrived at the SAVANNAH.
